

FY 2023 Executive Budget Amendments

**Amendments to Senate S.8006; Assembly A.9006  
(ELFA Article VII Bill)**

**Part A**, relating to implementation of the 2022-23 Executive Budget School Aid proposal, is amended to:

- Clarify that the form in which transportation contracts must be submitted to the State Education Department also includes an "electronic form approved by the commissioner when available" as a permissible submission.

**Part L**, relating to child care, is amended to:

- Make a technical correction for the effective date.

**Part U**, relating to the public benefits and requirements, is amended to:

- Make a technical amendment to ensure that the June 2022 obligation is removed, as intended, consistent with other changes to the public assistance program in this legislation.

**Part AA**, relating to the permit to create accessory dwelling units, is amended to:

- Removes the statewide requirement to provide for the creation of accessory dwelling units (ADUs), focusing instead on an authorization for New York City to establish a program to legalize pre-existing ADUs, including providing for amnesty.

**Part EE**, relating to transit oriented development, is amended to:

- Intentionally omit the part.

**Part II**, relating to the enactment of the Affordable Neighborhoods for New Yorkers Tax Incentive, is amended to:

- Make technical amendments to clarify the original intention of the bill.
